### **Chatsworth Cricket Club**

#### Baslow Players 1841-1846

The collection of newspaper cuttings in Gordon Bowering's book on Chatsworth Cricket Club contains the names of players in several matches in the 1840s to 1860s. I looked at the names and tried to find them in the Baslow Censuses of 1841-61 and in the Edensor/Chatsworth census of 1851.

Many of the names had no initials, and many of the surnames were common to both villages. My deductions may not be accurate. Errors will have occurred.

I made 10 hits for names from Baslow, and 5 from Edensor/Chatsworth. It is interesting that they are all workmen (with the exception of Broomhead son of the Innkeeper at the Peacock) who potentially could have worked for Chatsworth. It is possible that many players were Chatsworth employees.

The list below gives the list below gives the year of the match, and the team name as it appears in the original document. This is followed by the details from the census.

#### **Subscribers 1898 & 1899**

I have also looked at the balance sheets for 1898 and 1899. It appears that the Cricket Club had a lot of subscribers in Baslow and elsewhere. The full list, with the two years combined in a single table, is attached.

I have identified a number of subscribers from the Baslow 1891 and 1901 censuses, and have added the extra information about them to the list. I have marked the rest as "x not Baslow". Most of these will have come from Chatsworth or Edensor, some from elsewhere. A few may have been Baslow residents but for some reason were not included in the censuses There is no way of knowing who were players and who were sponsors. I have assumed that those who paid only 2s 6d (in either year) were players. All the rest, a big assumption, were sponsors
